



CARES ACT REPORT AND DISCLOSURE:

The Beauty Institute, Stroudsburg Campus (**OPE ID: 022063-00**) received education stabilization funds under Section 18004(a)(1) of the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act ("CARES Act"), Public Law No: 116-136. This Fund Report applies to the student portion received under the Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund that is designated exclusively for emergency financial aid grants to students.

The institution is making the below information available for transparency purposes and in compliance with the U.S. Department of Education's ("Department") Electronic Announcement of May 6, 2020.

1. **Certification :** The Beauty Institute has signed and returned to the Department the Certification and Agreement and the assurance that the institution has used, or intends to use, no less than 50 percent of the funds received under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students.
2. The total amount of the funds that The Beauty Institute will receive or has received from the Department pursuant to the institution's Certification and Agreement for Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students is \$142,607 (this includes the student portion only):

Determination of award: Emergency Financial Aid grant awards will be distributed equally to all eligible students enrolled in all programs who indicated they were effected by the Covid 19 outbreak and agree to use the funds to the following needs: food, housing, course materials technology, health care and /or child care.
